

SCOTCH COLLEGE ADELAIDE Old Collegians' Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 To be eligible for an Old Collegians' Scholarship at Scotch College Adelaide (the College), applicants must be Australian or New Zealand citizens or holders of an Australian Permanent Residence Visa who are:
 - 1.1.1 new students entering Year 10
 - 1.1.2 current students entering Year 10

A student is eligible for only one scholarship at any given time. Additional fee reductions cannot be applied.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 Be the son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter of an Old Collegian and be entering Scotch College in year 10.
- 2.2 Applicants must be willing and eager to participate in the wide range of opportunities available at the College and respect the philosophy, values, rules and policies of the College.

3. GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF ALL SCOTCH COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS:

- 3.1 Scholarship holders are role models and ambassadors of the College. They must demonstrate high standards of behaviour, leadership and presentation at all times. They must also set a positive example to the rest of the College; in particular those younger than themselves.
- 3.2 The scholarship holder should maintain a high commitment to their studies, demonstrated through a positive attitude, effort, and achievement.
- 3.3 Scholars must participate in an additional area of interest within the College.
- 3.4 The scholarship holder must consistently reflect the values of the College including honesty, integrity, leadership and inclusivity.
- 3.5 The scholarship holder must keep the amount of their scholarship confidential and not discuss it with other students, friends, or people outside their immediate family.





- 3.6 An annual review will be conducted to ensure scholars meet expectations.
- 3.7 If the scholarship holder does not meet the above requirements, the scholarship may not be renewed at the end of the academic year. In extreme cases, the scholarship may be withdrawn immediately.
- 3.8 A student can hold only one scholarship, which overrides any sibling discounts or special privileges.

4. STANDARDS, ACHIEVEMENT, ENGAGEMENT AND BEHAVIOURAL REQUIREMENTS:

All Old Collegians' Scholarship Holders must:

- 4.1 Adhere to the general expectations of all scholarship recipients.
- 4.2 Fully participate to the best of their ability in the academic life of the College and be willing to contribute widely to the College's co-curricular program.
- 4.3 Display strong qualities of service and leadership, be a role model to others, and be an outstanding ambassador for the College, their family, and the Old Collegians' Association.
- 4.4 Attend Old Collegians' meetings and events as an ambassador as required. They will also communicate information back to the student body.

5. OLD COLLEGIANS' SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND ACCEPTANCE

- 5.1 The scholarship award applies to the relevant day College tuition fees. It does not apply to costs associated with uniform, iPad, transport, textbooks and stationery, additional excursions, co-curricular activities, private vocal or instrumental lessons, sundry charges and other personal items. The cost of these items must be paid by the Old Collegian's Scholar's parents or legal guardians.
- 5.2 Scholarship recipients who are new students to the College must pay the application and enrolment fees upon acceptance of the Old Collegians' Scholarship. Current College students are not required to pay these fees.
- 5.3 Old Collegian Scholarships holders are expected to complete their schooling at Scotch College for the duration of the scholarship. If a student withdraws from the College before completion of the scholarship (3 years), the value of the scholarship up to the time of the student's withdrawal must be repaid by the parent who accepted the scholarship on behalf of the student. The Principal may, at their discretion, waive this obligation or set a lower amount to be repaid by the parent/guardian.
- 5.4 These Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with the College's applicable Student Enrolment Agreement, as amended from time to time.





6. SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW

- 6.1 The College reserves the right to review the performance of the Old Collegians' Scholar at any time.
- 6.2 Old Collegians' Scholars will participate in progress reviews to ensure they are conducting themselves according to the expectations of an Old Collegians' Scholar. Old Collegians' Scholars will work positively towards meeting all progress goals established as part of the review process.
- 6.3 The College may review the terms of the Old Collegians' Scholarship or discontinue the Old Collegians' Scholarship in circumstances where the terms and conditions of the Old Collegians' Scholarship are not being met.
